



Accommodation Rules

IMPORTANT NOTICE: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

1. The university reserves the right to reassign dormitories or rooms for legal or administrative reasons, and students are required to reside in the accommodation assigned by the university or dormitory management.
2. The Dormitory Affairs Office is responsible for the allocation of roommates based on the availability of facilities and accommodation space.
3. Any request to change rooms will only be considered under exceptional circumstances and must receive prior written approval from the Dormitory Affairs Office.
4. Residents are not permitted to host visitors unaffiliated with Shahid Sadoughi University of Medical Sciences, including guests, tutors, or students, without obtaining prior written approval from the International Relations Office. Such requests will be evaluated with consideration for the rights of roommates and the university's interests.
5. Students are fully responsible for any loss or damage to furnishings in their assigned rooms.
6. The university is not liable for any personal property that is lost, stolen, or damaged, irrespective of the cause.
7. Students must promptly report any maintenance issues related to their rooms. Failure to report such issues, or attempting to address them without proper authorization, will result in the student bearing full responsibility for any resulting financial costs or personal injuries.
8. Excessive use of utilities (water, gas, electricity) is prohibited and may incur additional charges.
9. Students are required to maintain cleanliness in their individual rooms and shared spaces, including but not limited to reading rooms, sports facilities, prayer halls, and television rooms.
10. For reasons of personal and public health, students must ensure that their rooms, units, and kitchens are kept clean, and they are expected to contribute to maintaining the cleanliness of shared facilities.
11. Each resident is responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their room and personal spaces, including refrigerators. The Dormitory Affairs Office will conduct regular inspections to ensure compliance with cleanliness standards.
12. The keeping of pets in university accommodations is strictly prohibited, as it poses risks to cleanliness, health, and the general well-being of residents.
13. Students are expected to adhere to standards of personal and public health at all times.
14. Smoking is strictly prohibited in all areas of the dormitory. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of pipes, hookahs, cigars, cigarettes, electronic devices, or any other smoking apparatus, regardless of the substance used.
15. The possession or use of smoking devices such as hookahs and pipes is strictly forbidden.
16. The possession, sale, purchase, or consumption of illegal food and beverages is strictly prohibited.



17. All students are expected to comply with the university's dress code while residing in university accommodations.
18. The possession, sale, purchase, or use of any illegal media, including unauthorized CDs, cassettes, and videos, is prohibited.
19. Any form of harassment, assault, or insult occurring within university dormitories constitutes a violation of university regulations. Furthermore, retaliation, interference, or coercion against any individual involved in reporting or investigating such incidents is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.
20. Physical or verbal altercations, including fighting, will be reported to the Student Disciplinary Committee and may result in suspension or expulsion of the involved parties.
21. Residents are expected to be mindful of noise levels at all times. Noise disturbances, including but not limited to loud conversations, amplified music, television, musical instruments, and radios, must be kept to a minimum to avoid disrupting others. Residents are required to comply with any requests to lower noise levels.
22. Disruptive behavior or excessive noise that disturbs other residents or neighbors is considered a violation of university policy.
23. Before embarking on any trips or excursions, students must inform the International Students Office and complete the necessary trip waiver form.
